

Options


- Manual security key lock

- Pre-drilled track and pre-installed striker blocks as requested


Slat Finishes

- · Satin (standard): A smooth anodized finish
- Brushed (optional): Keeps with the look of other brushed finishes on the vehicle.
- Perfect Match Wet Paint (optional):
 Complements your vehicle by using the same paint for the roll-up doors that is used on the truck.






- · Most commonly specified door type
- Operator is located at the front of the compartment to meet your equipment requirements
- · Counterbalanced for easy opening and closing
- · Easy to install and maintain
- · Made of individual aluminum slats, allowing quick repairs with little downtime
- End shoes are swaged/dimpled into the slat, not riveted, to allow easy slat replacement




Rear Roll Door Description

- Same features and options as front roll doors
- When equipment requirements don't allow a front roll, the operator is mounted toward the rear to better meet your needs
- Rear-mounted counterbalance maximizes compartment opening space
- Rear roll doors provide greatest benefits when compartment is more than 24" deep




AutoLatch Shutters for Interior Compartments

- AutoLatch rolls in a track across the top & down the back of the compartment
- Ideal for small compartments where space is at a premium
- · Easy to operate and virtually no maintenance
- The door stops raising or lowering as soon as you stop applying pressure
- Nylon inner seal between slats ensures quiet, vibration-free performance
- Interlocking nylon end shoes connecting the slats allow smooth operation
- Optional lock provides added security



M4000 Power Doors and Locks

- A push of a button, from the cab or other strategic location on the vehicle to raise the vehicle's roll-up doors
- As soon as the vehicle stops and the brakes are set, the doors are open
 That saves time, so personnel can focus on fighting fires and saving lives.
- The same switch can be activated to lower the doors and lock them securely



Minimum Header Shutter (MHS) Door Description

- . MHS shutter rolls in a track across the top of the compartment
- Ideal for compartments where header space id required to be at a minimum, such as ladder compartments
- Rear-mounted stainless steel cable counterbalance, which replaces the front operator, helps to maximize the compartment's clear opening space and minimize the header space requirements
- · Easy to install and maintain
